Update on project status

Background

- implementation and maintenance of the ATC/DDD index at national level is prone to errors and misalignments
- DDD per package calculation is usually manual
- lack of ATC/DDD-specific reporting recommendations and checklist for drug utilization/pharmacoepi studies

Overall project aim:

to foster replicability and comparability of studies based on the ATC/DDD standard

1) EMMA survey



Objectives:

- to collect nation-level information on methods, governance and documentation about the implementation and maintenance of the ATC/DDD standard

Status:

- Distribution ongoing: 76 nation-level expert from 51 countries already completed the survey
- Collection of experts' contacts open until end of April!!! *Suggestions???*

2) EMMA scoping review



Objectives:

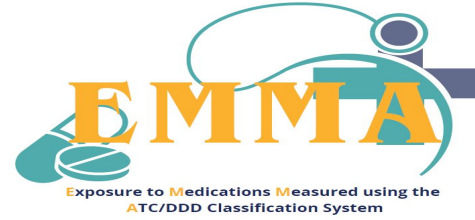
- To document how the use ATC/DDD methodology is reported in drug utilization/pharmacoepi studies published in 2022- 2023
- to create expert-based ATC/DDD-specific reporting recommendations and checklist leveraging results from scoping review and survey

(awarded by the ISPE Funded manuscript initiative!!!)

Status:

- 82 drug utilization/pharmacoepi studies included
- Data extraction to be started in April

3) EMMA recommendation on DDD per package calculator



Objectives:

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To develop recommendations for the design and creation of a prototype online application for the certified calculation of number of DDDs per package

Status:

- Kick-off done in February
